### Student Scholarships

In order to help the students for pursuing higher studies, different scholarships are being provided by state and central Government.

West Bengal scholarship is meant for students who are domicile of the state at both school and college levels. The scholarships for West Bengal aim at supporting meritorious, deserving, and underprivileged students of the state. They are run by the government of West Bengal and its subsidiary departments. Moreover, the state is also home to various reputed institutions of higher education like the Indian Institute of Management (Kolkata), Indian Institute of Technology (Kharagpur), Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (Kolkata), and National Institute of Technology (Durgapur) which makes the education for students of West Bengal easier and hassle-free.

### List of Scholarships:

### 1.Swami Vivekananda Merit cum-cum-Means Scholarship (SVMCM).

- This is one of the most popular merit-cum-means based scholarships for students of West Bengal that covers the education of students from Class 11 onwards.
- It is applicable only to minority community students.
- This scholarship offers financial assistance of up to INR 8000 per month depending on the course or level of the student's study.
- This scholarship is disbursed to students considering their academic merit and financial need.

#### 2.Kanyashree Prakalpa Scheme

Kanyashree Prakalpa Scheme was introduced by the Department of Women Development and Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal. a scheme. The key objective of Kanyashree Prakalpa is to improve the status of girl child in the state by incentivizing schooling of all teenage girls and preventing their early marriages.

The objective of the Kanyashree Prakalpa Scheme are as follows:

- To provide financial help to the girls from disadvantaged families to pursue higher studies
- To reduce dropouts, especially amongst girls from low-income families, who are not under any other scholarship
- To prevent child marriage in West Bengal by increasing the enrolment of girls in secondary education, vocational or sports training
- To encourage the delay of marriages for girls until they reach the age of 18
- · To help students to continue their education for a long time

- Functional under the Backward Classes Welfare Department, students of Classes 11th, 12th, graduation, and post-graduation are eligible to apply for this scholarship.
- The amount of scholarship that students can receive under this program may range from INR 160 to INR 1200 per month.
