#### 1. Title of the Best Practice: Green Initiatives and Environment Friendly Campus

- **2. Objectives of the Practice:** Green campus initiatives are integral part of the present-day education system. Educational institutions have an important role in promoting green practices. Our College actively supports the green campus program in order to support a sustainable and climate-friendly environment. The main objectives are-
- 1)To promote sustainable, climate friendly and eco-friendly green practices in the campus.
- 2)To promote alternative measures of energy in order to solve environmental challenges.
- 3)To establish an efficient way of waste management
- 4)To practice habit of not using plastic with in the campus.
- 5)To incorporate green protocol among students, staff and faculties.
- 6)To ensure proper waste, water and energy management with in the campus.
- 7)To decrease energy consumption and to enhance energy saving options efficiently.
- 9)To promote green landscaping in the campus
- 10)To raise mass awareness about plantation and sustainable environment.

#### 3.The Context:

The context that required the initiation of green practices are mainly Global Warming, Climate Change, increasing pollution, reducing resources and lack of awareness regarding environmental challenges. Clean and green environment is a basic necessity for human beings' health and efficiency. We decided to maintain a green space amid the urban metropolis. Our College campus has scanty open spaces. So we decided to have as much of green space in the campus as possible through vertical gardening and simultaneously practice and propagate sustainability.

#### **4.The Practice:**

Green campus sub-committee members of our College (includes Faculty and Green campus volunteer students) have participated in variety of activities to help protect the environment and sustain its natural resources. Our college is smoke-free and is also a single-use plastic-free **campus**. Our college promotes digitalisation and has partially paperless office and e-library. The college has installed **solar panels** on the roofs which generates solar energy. The power generation capacity of solar panels is 10 KVA (extending to generate around 40 KVA). This solar energy is systematically reducing conventional electricity consumption. There is solar power generating meter with solar panels which provides the daily data of carbon -di-oxide







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emission and saving of plants. From these data, it can be found that there is reduction of carbon in the environment, thus environmental pollution decreases. Some Entrepreneurship building Self employment Add-on courses on **Solar Panel Installation and Solar Technology** are taught in Bangabasi College.

The college has also installed **LED facilities** in the classroom, seminar room and examination room of the main campus. **Green campus volunteers** and other students take responsibility of switching off lights and fans when not in use. They also help in adding water to plants during free time.

Our college has taken an initiative to construct **rainwater harvesting** system at main campus. During rainy season the roof rain water is collected through filter-fitted pipes in a reservoir and use it later during fire drills, washing the roads and gardening purpose. The Rainwater harvesting unit in the backyard of the College is helping in conservation of water.

Our college has utilized its limited open space to the fullest. Many potted plants are kept in front of the college surrounding the bust of statues of our founder of the College. Lush green Madhabilata plant with fragrant flowers, over the front gate welcomes everyone to the college. Large neem tree and mango tree in the backyard are a paradise for the birds and purify the air as well. The branches of the Mango tree are spread beyond the campus. Green Committee and Zoology Department of Bangabasi College have taken initiative to make **nesting** on that tree. It has created environmental balance in Biodiversity inside as well as outside the campus.

Since our College campus has scanty open spaces, so we decided to increase greenery through vertical gardening. Both campuses harbour a diverse amount of flora and fauna components. Students learn about Medicinal plants (included in the B.Sc. Botany syllabus), which are planted in the campus. Medicinal Garden Committee which includes some Faculty of Department of Botany and other teachers maintain the Medicinal Garden within the college campus as a green campus initiative. Students are trained about the uses of different medicinal plants. Mushroom cultivation committee which includes some Faculty of Botany department are also engaged in Mushroom Cultivation which offers training programme for students related to mushroom cultivation which is a green initiative. It is a Health and Physical Fitness related Add-on course. It also enhances their entrepreneurship skill for future career.Bangabasi College has taken initiative for installation of a Vermi-Compost Unit in the Campus and train the students to produce Vermi-compost, a Green Manure with many benefits.

Our mission is to maintain the College campus clean and eco-friendly. In order to raise mass awareness, several activities are executed like observance of **World Environment Day**. On 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020 World Environment day was celebrated through online mode during pandemic period. Through online lectures by Teacher-in-Charge, Prof. Sibaprasad Das and Faculty and students of Department of Botany, messages to save the Environment were spread through YouTube. Also, with the initiative from College Administration and Green Campus Committee members, plantation drive **'Aranya Saptaha'** was celebrated in Bangabasi College with great enthusiasm on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2022 and 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2023. Aranya Saptaha marks the plantation drive which is celebrated for one week from 14 to 20<sup>th</sup> July every year in India. Saplings are distributed to students, faculty, non-teaching staff, local people and neighborhood shopkeepers.







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This was done to promote environmental awareness beyond the College campus. Saplings were carried home for planting by students and other stakeholders.

As a part of Environmental promotional activities and mass awareness for promoting use of Renewable Energy, Bangabasi College administration organized One Day International Conference on "Non- Conventional Renewable Energy: Impact on Environment" on 8<sup>th</sup> of April 2023, from 10 am at Ramakrishna Mission Residential College (Autonomous) Narendrapur. It was supported by Green Campus Sub-committee.

Again, Bangabasi College administration organized two day International Conference on "Renewable Energy and its Social Impact: Towards making Clean and Green India" on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> of August 2023 from 10:30am at Meghnad Saha Auditorium, Rashbehari Shiksha Prangan, University of Calcutta. The Conference was organized to celebrate 75 years of Independence of India "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav", sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR). As a part of Environmental Promotion activity, small green potted plants were distributed by the Convenor and members of Green Campus Sub-Committee and Green Volunteer students to felicitate the Honorable Dignitaries and Speakers.

Wildlife is an important part of our Environment. Bangabasi College gives priority to Environmental promotional activities like protection of Nature and Wildlife. Mass awareness regarding environment protection and maintenance of ecosystem balance among students and society is of utmost necessity. Keeping this mission in mind, UG and PG Students of Zoology Department of Bangabasi College took part in the **Wildlife Awareness Rally** organized by NGO "Anubhab: Expedition for better tomorrow", held on 18.11.18 and 13.11.22 Around 30 students and few Teachers took part in the rallies with poster reflecting awareness messages on protection of Wildlife and Nature.

Students are encouraged to participate in Quiz and Competitions on nature to increase awareness and promote green initiatives. UG and PG Department of Zoology regularly conducts Interdepartmental **Quiz competition** and **photography exhibition** on Nature and Wildlife to increase awareness regarding nature and wildlife among students. All the students were excited to participate in the program and received certificates and trophies also. Team of students from Zoology Department won 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Inter College Quiz competition on Wildlife and Nature, organized by Alipore Zoological Garden on 16.11.2018 and were awarded with a Trophy and a cash Prize of Rs 3000/-.

The College has Undertaken **Green Audit**, **Energy Audit and Environment Audit** for sessions, 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 and is planning to continue the assessment.

**5.Evidence of Success: Green Campus volunteers** are mostly undergraduate students (around 30) of Botany, Zoology, Geography and other departments and also from NCC and NSS. They actively take part in all activities of Green campus Sub-committee. Green volunteers and other students take responsibility for switching off lights and fans when not in use. They also help in adding water to plants during free time. This has developed a sense of responsibility in them and they get a better understanding of their role as advocates of environmental conservationists. Through **plantation, Conferences, quiz, rallies and seminars,** students and others are made aware of the various environmental issues. Large number of students, Faculty, research scholars from colleges participated in the **International** 







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Conference organized by our College which is appreciable. The waste disposal management initiative taken by our college is yielding very good results.

Through periodical tree plantations, flora and fauna on the campus have been enriched, resulting in the transformation of the campus into an eco-friendly one. An awareness campaign for the **plastic-free campus** through signboards and display boards has made the campus overall plastic free. Students try to avoid using plastics and smoking in campus. Also, the **solar energy** generated by the installed solar panels plays an important role as a renewable energy source. By installing solar panel college saves on the monthly electricity bill. Students get to see and learn about **medicinal plants** of our campus. Special attraction by the students has also been found towards **Mushroom cultivation and Vermicomposting** which may help them in future for the development of their entrepreneurship skills.

#### 6.Problems encountered and Resources required

The main problem encountered in the Green campus initiative is need of large sum of funds for the development and maintenance of infrastructure for the green practices. For Implementation of the green practices more awareness programs to educate people are required. Adopting green practices needs investment and also a strong desire and participation from all the beneficiaries. Huge amount of Resources was needed ranging from infrastructure to equipment and skills. All were made available.

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






